Pacific Partnership 2018 Training Nursing Students

The Pacific Partnership 2018 Medic Team conducted a basic skills training for the Palau Community College Nursing students. The Navy service men were Joe Pinon, Chris Jack, and Jason Bennet. All members of the team have field experience in basic medic aid and were very excited to do presentation to the nursing students. The presentation was held at the PCC lower campus Nursing Classroom at the Sebus building. The focus of the training was to equip students with the Basic Task Trainers/Simulation Training with mannequin.

All task trainers have the ability to break down a specific physical task into action steps and pieces of information. Most task trainers use mannequins, a lifelike models of body parts, such as an arm or pelvis. for simulation, Others are non-anatomical and utilize mechanics or other means to teach biological concepts. Task trainers help a learner develop both confidence and proficiency. Once a task trainer achieve high level of competence with the training, they will be ready to perform the same skill on a real patient. PCC nursing students were exposed to various simulations such as Airway Management, Insertion Simulation, Central Venous, Catheterization (CVC), IV Cannulation, and Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR).

UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION (USDOE) FEDERAL UPDATES

The Pell Grant Award for 2018-2019 Award Year

The maximum Pell Grant Award will increase to \$6,095 for 2018-2019 Award Year, and the corresponding maximum Pell Grant eligible expected family contribution (EFC) will increase to 5486. The actual 2018-2019 award year minimum scheduled award amount will be \$650.


Year-Round Pell Grants

The Year-Round Federal Pell Grant Program will continue through 2018-2019 Award Year. The program allows an eligible student to receive up to 150 percent of the student's Federal Pell Grant Scheduled Award which is equivalent to \$8,880.

To be eligible for the additional Pell Grant funds, the student must be otherwise eligible to receive Pell Grant funds for the payment period and must be enrolled at least half-time, in the payment period(s) for which the student receives the additional Pell Grant funds in excess of 100 percent of the student's Pell Grant Scheduled Award.

Any Pell Grant received will be included in determining the student's Pell Grant duration of eligibility and Lifetime Eligibility Used (LEU).
