NIH-NIDDK STEP-UP Officials Visit PCC

On January 23, 2019 National Institute of Health - National Institute of Diabetes and Digestive and Kidney Diseases (NIH-NIDDK) officials visited the campus and met with PCC President Dr. Patrick U. Tellei. They also had the opportunity to visit local high schools in Palau and provided information about NIH-NIDDK Short-Term Research Experience for Underrepresented Persons (STEP-Up) program which is hosted by the college. The STEP-Up program is designed to provide opportunities for individual high school students in biomedical and behavioral research as well as hands-on clinical laboratory and social/behavioral research during summer session. The main purpose is to ignite and foster students' interest in scientific research and investigation leading up to careers in medical and/ or science field. Since 2014, STEP-Up has had students from various high schools in Palau participating in an eight (8) week summer program. Students also had the opportunity to present their research abstract/projects at the end of summer at the National Institute of Health in Bethesda, Maryland.

26th National Law Enforcement Academy to Commence Soon

The 26th National Law Enforcement Academy is slated to commence on Monday, January 28, 2019. According to Lt. Commander Jeff Eriich, academy cadets are currently assigned to do general clean up of the classroom and exterior grounds including parking stalls in preparation for the first day of class.

The National Law Enforcement Academy runs for three (3) months period which all participants undergo rigorous physical training and studying to improve their abilities to serve as law enforcement officers. Included in the group are employees of the Bureau of Customs, State employees, and individuals with personal interests in the program.

At the end of three months, The academy will awards cadets in these categories: The Perfect Attendance, Outstanding Leadership, Top Physical Fitness, Top Academic and the Against All Odds Award.



 - a. Example: E-Van Ongrung.....e-vano
 - b. Example: Mary Jane Goodman.....maryjaneg
 - c. Example: O.J. Woodward.....ojw
- Your password is your student ID number and it can be found on your PCC student ID card.
 - NOTE: Social Security number is not a password so if your ID number on your student ID card is your SS number then please kindly stop by at Registrars Office and request for your correct student ID number.
