From June 17-21, 2019 the Cooperative Research & Extension (CRE) Division of Palau Community College (PCC) conducted an Expanded Food & Nutrition Education Program (EFNEP) and Food Technology Training at the Airai Ked Center. A group of eighteen individuals participated in the training. EFNEP and the Food Technology Training aims to provide families in Palau with information about basic nutrition based on locally grown ingredients & supplies. The program and training provides demonstrations on how to create healthy meals with local ingredients and tips on safe food-handling & storage that can help improve personal eating habits. Step 2

Submit the non-refundable application fee

Submit non-refundable application fee of \$10.00. You can pay using cash or credit or debit card at PCC Business Office or mail a check or money order to the Admissions & Records Office. Please make sure to make the check payable to Palau Community College. *DO NOT SEND CASH.*

Step 3

Request for your official high school transcript(s) to be sent to PCC

Request for official transcript(s) from high school (and/or college) attended to be sent directly from the institution to PCC Admissions & Records Office. Transcript should include the graduation date, an official school seal, and a school official's signature.

Step 4

Submit required documentation

Submit copies of a 1) Legal ID (i.e., passport, driver's license, or birth certificate) and a 2) Social Security card.

Step 5

Request to have official SAT/ACT/TOEFL scores sent to PCC

If you have taken any of the standardized tests, request for official test scores to be sent from testing services to PCC.

Step 6

Fill out the FAFSA

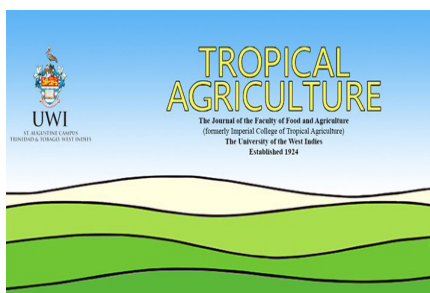
