Workshop on Developmental Courses

Last week, the Student Life & Housing Unit of Palau Community College (PCC) held workshop sessions that focused on developmental courses. Information provided during the sessions covered the following objectives: developmental courses & placement testing; the importance of passing developmental courses on first attempts in order to remain eligible for financial aid coverage; and the services, such as the tutoring services at the Learning Resource Center (LRC), at the college that can assist students pass their courses. Developmental courses are designed to help students who are ranked below college-level in English writing and mathematics. A student may be placed in a developmental course, depending on how he or she scored on the placement examination, in order to learn the basic concepts of a subject area before continuing on to the college level courses.



The opening ceremony began with welcoming remarks from the Czech Republic Honorary Consul to Palau Sandra S. Pierantozzi. Honorary Consul Pierantozzi introduced Palau Minister of State Billy G. Kuartei who gave the host remarks. Minister Kuartei was followed by the Ambassador of Italy to Palau Massimo Roscigno.

In his message, Ambassador Roscigno commented that the movies shared in the film festival showcase how Europe was a collection of different societies. Although the countries were united as one continent, each country had its share of traditions & culture. The annual film festival was an opportunity for the European countries to share a part of their culture with Palau.

Ambassador of the Czech Republic to Palau Jaroslav Olša, Jr., followed with the presentation of the Medal of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs from the Czech Republic. The Medal of Foreign Affairs from the Czech Republic is presented to individuals who have had a significant role in strengthening the relations between the Czech Republic and other countries. The medal was awarded to PCC President Dr. Patrick U. Tellei who has been a long-time supporter of the European film festival in Palau. PCC President Dr. Tellei is the first Palauan recipient of the medal.

The European Film Festival, which has been hosted in Palau since 2009, is supported annually by the Embassy of the Czech Republic in Manila. It was established by former Czech Republic Ambassador to Palau Jaroslav Ludva. Movies featured in this year's festival were *Rise Up! and Dance* from Austria, *Přijde letos Ježíšek?* (Miracle in Prague) from the Czech Republic, *Les garçons et Guillaume, à table!* (Me, Myself, and Mum) from France, *Ein Geschenk der Götter* (A Godsend) from Germany, *Habemus Papam!* (We Have a Pope!) from Italy, *SOOF* from the Netherlands, *O Apóstolo* (The Apostle) from Spain, and *Vielen Dank für Nichts* (Keep Rollin') from Switzerland.
