# Financial Aid Night Sessions with High Schools Seniors & Parents

Financial Aid Night Session with Emmaus-Bethania High School and Belau Modekngei High School

According to the new federal updates, the filing of 2017-2018 FAFSA for next school year begins on October 01, 2016 instead of the usual date which always begins on January 01 of each year.

The Director of Admissions & Financial Aid, Ms. Dahlia M. Katosang, and her staff conducted a total of five (5) Financial Aid Night Sessions from Friday, October 07, 2016 to Sunday, October 16, 2016 at the Palau Community College (PCC) Assembly Hall for eligible high school seniors and their parents.

During the sessions, Director Katosang discussed Federal Student Aid Programs, its eligibility requirements, and assisted interested students with completing the financial aid forms including the 2017-2018 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

Over 80% of all eligible high school seniors and their parents attended the Financial Aid Night Sessions. The PCC Admissions & Financial Aid Office will continue to reach the remaining 32 seniors (26 from PHS, 5 from PMA, and 1 from EBHS) who did not attend the session & offer assistance. # Japanese Student Visits PCC

On October 19, 2016 a student from the Tokyo University of Arts visited Palau Community College (PCC). Mr. Masayuki Oka met with PCC President Dr. Patrick U. Tellei to discuss the progress of his research regarding the Yapese Stone Money, a round disc made of limestone that was mined from the rock islands of Airai and Koror over a century ago. Mr. Oka's interest in Palau and the Yapese Stone Money began when his family donated an authentic Yapese Stone Money to the Japanese national Park. The stone money belonged to Mr. Oka's great-grandfather who had lived in Palau for seven (7) years during the Japanese Era. PCC President Dr. Tellei gave Mr. Oka a personal tour of the campus. They visited the PCC Administration Building which served as a Japanese Hospital. PCC President Dr. Tellei also presented Mr. Oka with a book entitled "Government of Palau: A Nation that Honors Its Traditions" as an aide in his research. Mr. Oka has been working on his research for two (2) months.


