The following are changes/corrections for the 2016 - 2020 General Catalog.

- 1. **MA101 Math for Mechanics:** (*Page 92 under Course Descriptions*)
  The credit notation should read 2 credits lec., 1 credit lab. in place of 3 credits lec.
- 2. **CJ113 Juvenile Justice** (*Page 78 Course Descriptions*) The correct prerequisite is EN92 and EN95 rather than CJ111.
- 3. Community and Public Health program degree requirements: (Page 52 under Required General Education Courses)
  - The correct title for MA95 should read "Basic Algebra"

  - The correct title for PW240 should read "Field Studies: Traditional Field Applications" to replace "Palauan Traditional Course Topics"
- **6.** Air Conditioning and Refrigeration program degree requirements: (Page 49 under other required courses)
  - The correct title for WE110 should read "Gas Welding and Cutting"
- 7. Small Engine and Outboard Marine Technology program degree requirements: (Page 61 under other required courses)
  - The correct title for WE110 should read "Gas Welding and Cutting"

- 8. Entrance Requirements AS (Page 45 under Associate of Science Degree)
  Delete under step 1 the following "OR currently enrolled student with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0.
  - The correct entrance requirements for the Associate of Science degree are as follows:
    - 1. Be a high school or adult high school graduate with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5; OR possess a GED diploma with a minimum score of 450 on all five sections.

2. Be a currently enrolled student with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5.
