Subject: 2012 - 2016 General Catalog Addendum #2

The following are changes/modifications that had been approved by CPC for 2012 - 2016 General Catalog. Effective date is Fall 2013.

- 1. <u>Course Modification</u>: SC 201 Oceanography (*Page 106 under Courses Description*)

 Change in prerequisite: SC 120 will remain as only prerequisite for SC 201. Delete SC 170.
- 2. <u>Course Modification</u>: ED 202 Early Childhood Development (*Page 90 under Course Description*) Change in prerequisite: Change from ED 201 to TOEFL score of 450.
- 3. <u>Course Modification</u>: **ED 110 & ED 192** (Merging ED 110 & ED 192 into one course as ED 110: Introduction to Teaching / Practicum of 3 credits)

ED 192 - Practicum: Observation and Participation (1cr)

ED 110 – Introduction to Teaching / Practicum

Semester Credits: 3

Course Description As It Will Appear in the Catalog:

This course assists the prospective teachers in evaluating personal qualifications in light of the criteria for successful classroom teaching and helps the students make a well-informed decision for or against a career in teaching. The course will also provide students an opportunity to observe actual classroom teaching and learning; be familiarized with the responsibilities of a classroom teacher, teaching materials and the general operation of a school; and will have an opportunity to discuss and share their observations and findings. Pre: A minimum TOEFL score of 450. (2 credits lec., 1 credit lab).

The following changes need to be applied to each track (Early Childhood Education, Elementary Education, Special Education, Secondary Education) under Education Program (ED) effective Fall 2013.

- Change ED 110 Introduction to Teaching to ED 110 Introduction to Teaching / Practicum
- Delete ED 192 Practicum: Observation & Participation
