The following are changes/corrections for the 2016 - 2020 General Catalog.

1. PW240 Field Studies: Traditional Field Application

The correct number of credits is 4 credits internship.

2. Palauan Studies Program (page 61)

The total number of *credits for required program courses* is 22.

The total number of credits required for the program is 60.

3. Associate of Science Entrance Requirements – AS (page 45)

Delete under step 1 the following "OR currently enrolled student with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0."

- The correct entrance requirements for the Associate of Science degree are as follows:
  - 1. Be a high school or adult high school graduate with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5; OR possess a GED diploma with a minimum score of 450 on all five sections. OR
  - 2. Be a currently enrolled student with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5,

- Have a TOEFL score of at least 500.
- 4. Associate of Arts and Technical Studies Entrance Requirements (pages 46 and 47)

- 3. Have a TOEFL score of at least 500.
- 5. Education Program All Education program track degree requirements (Pages 53-54 under required program courses)
  - The correct title for ED215 should read "Mainstreaming Exceptional Individuals"
  - The correct prerequisite is ED110 and SS201 or ED110 and ED202.

- 6. **Liberal Arts program** the courses HI149 and HP104 are officially deleted courses and should be removed from the Liberal Arts program. On page 64 under Humanities, delete HI149 and under Health and Physical Education, delete HP104.
- 7. **Business Administration and Business Accounting programs** on pages 50 and 51, the correct title for BA214 should read "Introduction to Business Law."
- 8. **Community and Public Health program** on page 52, the correct title for CPH165 should read "Introduction to *Emergency Health Management.*"
- Delete ET220 Electrical Management and Maintenance from page 87. This course was officially deleted from the Electrical Technology program.
- 10. With the required changes of developmental courses implemented in fall 2016, credit courses using developmental course(s) as pre-requisite(s) were revised to reflect the changes. Note the following courses with approved changes of pre-requisites below.
