Subject: 2016 - 2020 General Catalog Addendum #4

The following are changes/corrections for the 2016 - 2020 General Catalog.

1. New courses

MA103 Basic Mathematics This course is designed to prepare students for other courses which require basic skills in mathematics. Topics include whole numbers, integers, fractions, decimals, ratio and proportion, measurement, percent, graphs and statistics, and introduction to geometry. Pre: None (2 credits lec, 1 credit lab)

EN100 English Reading and Writing This is a reading and writing course which focuses on enhancing the students' ability in reading comprehension and improving writing skills that are essential for successful study. Coursework will include identifying and understanding key elements of reading selections, understanding the steps to the writing process, and introducing the basic essay structures. Effective writing and organization of three-paragraph essays will be covered. A strong emphasis will be on the value of relating the reading comprehension techniques to the process of writing effectively. Pre: None (2 credits lecture, 1 lab)

2. Prerequisite changes

SC205 Physics I – the prerequisite is now SC119 and MA112.

MA105 Intermediate Algebra – the prerequisite is now MA103.

EN109 Advanced Reading - the prerequisite is now EN100.

EN112 Freshman Composition – the prerequisite is now EN100.

NOTE: Continuing students who took EN95 do not need to take EN100 prior to taking EN109 or EN112. Continuing students who have not taken EN95 prior to enrolling in EN109 or EN112 need to take EN100 to meet the EN109 and EN112 prerequisites.

Continuing students who took MA95 do not need to take MA103 prior to enrolling in MA105. Continuing students who have not taken MA95 need to take MA103 to meet the MA105 prerequisite.

3. Program requirement changes

Community and Public Health (CPH) Program – the general education math requirement is now MA103

Nursing (NU) Program – the general education math requirement is now MA103

4. Credit changes

MA105 Intermediate Algebra has laboratory hours now. The credit distribution is 2 credits lecture and 1 credit laboratory.
