2017 PCC Thanksgiving Endowment Fundraiser

Palau Community College (PCC) held its annual Thanksgiving Endowment Fundraising Event on Wednesday November 22, 2017. The college was able to raise \$63,655.93 due to the support of the community members who purchased raffle tickets (\$32,040), donated cash (\$31,615.93). Local businesses and agencies also supported the fundraiser by donating In-Kind prizes for the event raffle drawing.

This year, the PCC Thanksgiving Endowment Fundraiser had a total of sixty (60) prizes, one (1) baby grand prize, and one (1) grand prize. The grand prize included a 14'x 24' Summer House valued at \$5,500, overnight fishing trip, paddle board, PCC-CRE book entitled Flowers of the Pacific, and gift certificate for 25lbs. of reef fish from PCC-CRE.

Other prizes included gift certificates from the Palau Coffee Beanery, Palau Pacific Resort (PPR), Palau Royal Resort (PRR), Palau Water, Side Street Cafe, Shawarma Corner, Sonia's Beauty Salon, R&C Bait & Tackle, The Taj Restaurant, Carp Corporation, PICRC, Palau Beach Bangalow, Desomel Restaurant at PALASIA, Tyuladokow Wood Shop and PNCC.
