Mr. Kobayashi is one of the 26 fellow researcher in the Ocean Policy Research Department at the Sasakawa Peace Foundation. The Sasakawa Peace Foundation's priority goals for 2017 is to 1) further strengthening Japan - U.S. relationship, (2) expanding Japan's presence in Asia, (3) enhancing understanding on and relationship with Islamic countries, (4) establishing ocean governance and (5) empowering women.
