On September 11, 2018, Palau Community College held the 17th 9-11 memorial service to remember the victims and honor the heroes of September 11, 2001 terror attack on the United States of America, an in effect the free world. 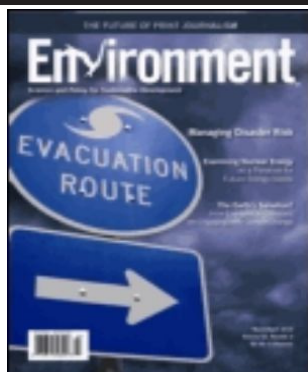
