UPWARD BOUND PROGRAM



Program Description

Upward Bound provides fundamental support to participants in their preparation for college entrance. The program provides opportunities for participants to succeed in their precollege performance and ultimately in their higher education pursuits. Upward Bound serves high school students from low-income families and/or high school students from families in which neither parent holds a bachelor's degree. The goal of Upward Bound is to increase the rate at which participants complete secondary education and enroll in and graduate from institutions of postsecondary education.

Who is eligible to participate in an Upward Bound Project?

An individual is eligible to participate in a Upward Bound project if he/she meets all of the following requirements:

- Is a citizen, permanent resident, or national of the United States; a permanent resident of Guam, the Northern Mariana Islands, or the Trust Territory of the Pacific Island; a resident of the Freely Associated States — the Federated States of Micronesia, the Republic of Palau, or the Republic of the Marshall Islands
- A potential first-generation college student; or a low-income individual
- Has a need for academic support and must plan to pursue a college education beyond high school
- At the time of initial selection, has completed the eighth grade but has not entered the twelfth grade and is at least 13 years old but not older than 19



Types of Services

Upward Bound Program consists of Academic Year Component and a Summer Component which includes such activities as follows:

Academic Year Component - October to May

- Instruction in Math, Foreign Language, Literature, Composition, and Laboratory Science
