On October 15 - 19, 2018 Palau Community College Continuing Education hosted the Pre-Hospital Trauma Life Support (PHTLS) training with instructor Edward Caballero to all the firefighters from Palau Fire & Rescue Services at the Ministry of Justice. The course modules focused on the immediate identification and treatment of patients that suffer a traumatic injury with emphasis on childrens traumatic injuries. This one-week's training was possible through needed funding from Ministry of Health (MOH) - Hospital Emergency Preparedness Program (HEPP) and Emergency Medical Services for Children (EMSC).

The participants of this training are taught by volunteer instructors to provide needed basic caregiving skills. The training session is one-week in which various modules are taught each night of the week. Each module covers different aspect of caregiving such as proper way to prepare meals for a patient, personal hygiene, and different illnesses that may plague a patient. In addition, trainees learn how to deal with the emotional and physical stresses of the occupation.
