On August 28-29, 2018 Palau Community College staff went through a two-day assessment training on Nuventive Improve (formerly TracDat) software program. Over 30 staff from Admissions & Registrar Office, Financial Aid Office, Cafeteria, Student Life Office, Bookstore, Development Office, Business, Computer Services Office, Human Resource, Physical Plant, Library, Continuing Education Office, Learning Resource Center, Adult High School Office, Dean of Students Office, Academic Affairs Office, Cooperative Research & Extension, TRIO Talent Search, and Upward Bound program participated in this assessment training. The training provide for participants the tool to be used to assess their Non-Academic and Non-Instructional service area by entering data results from their respective area evaluation.
