2018 PCC Thanksgiving Endowment Fundraiser

Palau Community College (PCC) held its annual Thanksgiving Endowment Fundraising Event on Wednesday November 21, 2018. The college was able to raise \$60,000.00 due to the support of the community members who purchased raffle tickets (\$31,000), donated cash (\$28,600), and gave pledges via telephone (\$400). Local businesses and agencies also supported the fundraiser by donating prizes for the raffle drawing.

This year, the PCC Thanksgiving Endowment Fundraiser had a total of sixty (60) prizes and one (1) grand prize. The grand prize included a 14'x 24' Summer House valued at \$6,500. Baby grand prize: Stand-Up paddle board with \$500 cash, and first prize: Amana freezer with gift certificate and \$400 cash. Other prizes were Whirlpool washing machine, Mitsubishi weed eater with Palau Beach Bungalow certificate, and 25 lbs. Reef fish from PCC-Cooperative Research and Extension.

Other prizes included gift certificates from the Palau International Coral Reef Center, Palau Royal Resort (PRR), Palau Water, R&C Bait & Tackle, Tiuladokow Wood Shop, Sam's Dive Tour, and Palasia Hotel.

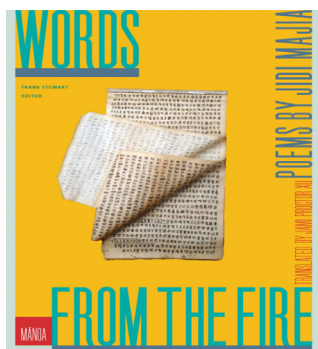
