Speaking to a gathering of students in the PCC Assembly Hall, Yamanguchi who is herself an alumni of the Upward Bound program, shared with the students the importance of learning proper study skills and habits. Yamanguchi's presentation identified easy step-by-step methods that students can incorporate into their daily study routine both in and out of the classroom which can help them improve their study habits and knowledge retention tendencies. End-Of-Semester Faculty Meeting




