On Thursday, February 14, 2019 Palau Community College Academic Affairs and Student Services Divisions conducted recruitment activities to seniors at Palau High School.

The recruitment activity is part of the overall college 15-Year Institutional Master Plan to increase enrollment by 10% in 2024 for career and technical programs but also for School of Arts and Sciences and School of Business.

Over 60 Palau High School seniors attended the college recruitment activity to hear Dean of Academic Affairs Robert Ramarui provide information on the college 21 academic programs followed by Dean of Students Sherman Daniel who provide information on the college student support services.

- Your password is your student ID number and it can be found on your PCC student ID card.
 - NOTE: Social Security number is not a password so if your ID number on your student ID card is your SS number then please kindly stop by at Registrars Office and request for your correct student ID number.
