

#### Submit the non-refundable application fee

Submit non-refundable application fee of \$10.00. You can pay using cash or credit or debit card at PCC Business Office or mail a check or money order to the Admissions & Records Office. Please make sure to make the check payable to Palau Community College. DO NOT SEND CASH.

Step 3

#### Request for your official high school transcript(s) to be sent to PCC

Request for official transcript(s) from high school (and/or college) attended to be sent directly from the institution to PCC Admissions & Records Office. Transcript should include the graduation date, an official school seal, and a school official's signature.

Step 4

#### Submit required documentation

Submit copies of a 1) Legal ID (i.e., passport, driver's license, or birth certificate) and a 2) Social Security card.

Step 5

#### Request to have official SAT/ACT/TOEFL scores sent to PCC

If you have taken any of the standardized tests, request for official test scores to be sent from testing services to PCC.

Step 6

#### Fill out the FAFSA
