Two representatives from the USP Pacific European Union Marine Partnerships Project (PEUMP) met with PCC President Dr. Tellei and also had meetings with various stakeholders in Palau to discuss collaboration and project updates on PEUMP. The team members include Dr Rusila Savou and Shirleen Bala.

The PEUMP project is a EUR 45M Pacific regional initiative funded by the European Union (EU) and the Government of Sweden, working in partnership with the Pacific Community (SPC), Secretariat of the Pacific Environment Programme (SPREP), Forum Fisheries Agency (FFA) and the University of the South Pacific (USP) to implement activities across six key result areas (KRAs) in 15 Pacific countries.
