Make sure you have an ACTIVE email account so that you can create a <u>course account</u> when you come for orientatation. Check your email account BEFORE your orientation schedule so that you know what your password is and if your email account is still active!

If you have not used your email account in a while, please check it BEFORE you come for orientation to make sure that you can still use it. If it is no longer working or you forgot your password, create a new account to use for your online course. The suggested email account to use is a Gmail account.

Students who have taken online courses prior to spring 2020 will need to make a new Moodle account; be sure to come as this is part of orientation. Try to come at your scheduled time but if you have another course scheduled at that time, come to the other orientation time.
