PCC Library Recieves New Donations

PCC library is fortunate to recently receiving donations of dictionaries, language grammars, reference books and other valuable books from Miss Janos Samu. Ms. Samu has been living in the island of Kauai for the last 23 years. She has been a writer and translator for the past 54 years. She considers herself Hawaiian in heart. She loves and respect the people of the Pacific islands and therefore, thought that she could enrich PCC library with a part of her collection.

Food Security Program March - April 2020

The objective of the program is to conduct scientific research to disseminate results to the community, and increased local food production based on conservation agriculture to achieve self-sufficiency.

The program continues its project doing research on sustainable taro production based on conservation agriculture to increase yield in upland taro production (Sers). Harvesting of the experiment plots was conducted. There were 14 experiment plots of 15x30 feet square for different tillage techniques and mulch. The experiment consists of 2 plots for conventional and 12 plots for conservation agriculture. The results showed that conservation agriculture based tillage increased taro yield by 2.2-2.6 times than conventional tillage. Practicing this method is recommended to the community for sustainable taro production for food security.




Fig1. Effect of tillage techniques, mulch, and intercropping on biomass & yield of taro
