Mangrove Crab Seeds Released in Ngchesar State



PCC CRE & Ngchesar State Government release mangrove crab seeds

To help enhance the local mangrove crab wild population in Palau, the Palau Community College Cooperative Research and Extension (PCC-CRE) continued to release mangrove crab seeds along the country's vast mangrove areas. Together with the Ngchesar State Government, the PCC-CRE aquaculture staff released about 3.6 million newly hatched mangrove larvae along Ngchesars' coastal mangrove areas last Wednesday, December 2, 2020. During the release, the PCC aquaculture researcher explained to the clients that out of the millions of larvae that were released about 0.01 percent are expected to be retrieved in the mangroves due to various circumstances that affect their survival rate in the wild. The Protected Network (PAN) officer Verano Ngirkelau acknowledged the positive impact of this effort by stating that the crab larval released in 2018 increased the number of mangrove crabs in their area months after their release. He also encouraged PCC to continue in this effort and expressed their support in monitoring the post release survey of the wild mangrove crab population in the future.




