On December 23, 2020 Minister of Education Dr. Sinton Soalablai met with PCC President Dr. Patrick U. Tellei and presented his Doctor of Education dissertation which was finally approved by the Walden University project study committee. The dissertation titled "Teachers' Use of Technology in Lesson Planning and Presentation in Palau" was a partial fulfillment of the requirements for the degree of Doctor of Education. The focus of the dissertation is to proposed policy recommendations for MOE leadership to move forward with the technology program and continue to build on the recent investments as part of the MOE's 10-year Year Master Plan 2017–2026. Also, MOE leadership will ensure that research considerations become part of any program's development and planning and the organization's general data-gathering processes.

The final recommendation of the study was to have MOE conduct a follow-up study to determine if the role and impact of the various components of the teacher's use of technology in lesson planning and presentation were met. With this, MOE leadership will have data to begin deliberating on the next steps. The study also presented a scholarly review of the literature on policy development guidelines and recommendations that the ministry could use to make appropriate decisions. In light of this, MOE will have the opportunity to create positive social change for the students it serves by facilitating technology-driven instruction aligned to the demands of a first-class, 21st-century education.
