SDSU Master's Cohort Students Present Research Projects



PCC & SDSU Master's Program cohort

From January 19 - 20, 2021 San Diego State University Master's program students showcase their academic research project via presentation as part of the requirement for PA 600 "Scope in Public Administration" course.

The focus of the course employs a global comparative approach to introduce students to the structures, behaviors, and processes of public administration with an emphasis on exploring the role of public management systems within the wider political and democratic frameworks in which they function in a global environment.

An overview of the history and intellectual foundation of public administration including the major ideas, developments, theories, concepts, and contributors to the growth of public administration and its practice in the United States. In addition, students are introduced to the case analysis method and literature review to expand their understanding of the subject.

Present to facilitate students project presentations was Ms. Sandra Pierantozzi and SDSU distance education coordinator in Palau, Dean of Continuing Jefferson Thomas. Dean Thomas reiterated that "students will begin the third class in a week from today".

The inauguration ceremony included the leadership of both the legislative and the executive branches of the government, the traditional and state leaders as well as members of the public. The ceremony began with the introduction and seating of honored guests by Ms. Kiruu Kuartei followed by presentation of colors and prayers. PCC President Dr. Patrick U. Tellei, chairman of the Inauguration Committee then gave opening remarks, highlighting the history of Palau's constitutional government. Pandemic Safety Certification Training



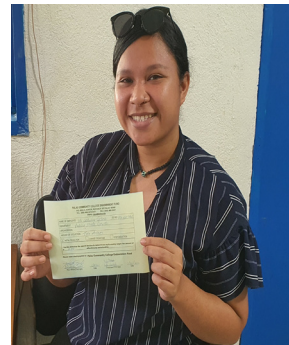

From January 18-19, 2021 Palau Community College in collaboration with Bureau of Tourism (BOT), Palau Chamber of Commerce, Palau Visitors Authority (PVA), Palau Red Cross Society (PRCS), Palau Small Business Development Center (SBDC), U.S. Department of State-USAID, and UN International Organization for Migrant (IOM) hosted a Pandemic Safety Certification training at PCC Assembly Hall. This one-and-half day training is train-the-trainers on COVID-19 impacts on tourism industry, travel advisory and visitor expectations, prevention, safety & hygiene etiquettes. Safety guidelines were provided to participants in tour operation business, hotel accomodation, food service establishments, land tour services, and transportation companies. Training preparation and practice were also conducted using method of learning such as presentations and break out sessions. The certification training ensures that Palau tourism industry personnel are well trained on interantional best practices for safety and sanitation onset of the COVID-19 Pandemic.

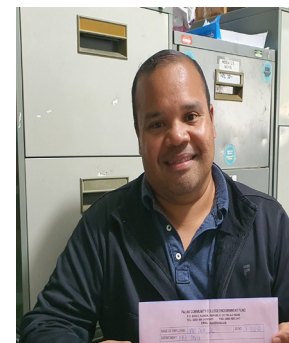

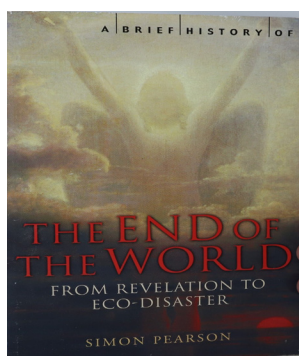
