SDSU Master's Cohort Begins ARP 740 Course

On February 01, 2021 San Diego State Universrity Master's Cohort lead off this new year with a start of ARP 740 course. The course is focused on fiscal and legal issues in school administration which gives students basic understanding of public sector financial management and budgeting.
