On Friday, February 12, 2021 Palau Community College President Dr. Patrick U. Tellei met with Senator Andrew Tabelual, Chairman of the Senate Committee on Education and Senator Kazuki Topps Sungino, Vice Chairman of the Senate Committee on Education at PCC Conference room. President Dr. Tellei began with a warm welcome to both senator Tabelual and senator Sungino to the college campus. The purpose of the meeting was information via a short presentation by PCC President Dr. Tellei on the college's programs and services. PCC CE Palauan Language Class for Non-Palauans Underway

On Tuesday, February 16, 2021 Palau Community College Continuing Education begins basic conversational Palauan course. A total of 48 non-palauan speakers are enrolled in the Palauan language course. Participants are divided into 3 classes each with different time and dates. The purpose of the course is to introduce basic pronunciation of Palauan letters, sound blending of Palauan syllabic vowels and consonants for most frequently used words, and also introductory greetings, directional words, vocabularies and phrases used in everyday. Instructors for the courses are Dean of CE Jefferson Thomas, Lady Ngi-ratkakl, and Yvonne Ruluked. Courses are scheduled on Tuesdays and Thursdays with group one from 9 to 11 a.m., group 2 from 4 to 6 p.m., and group 3 from 6 to 8 p.m.

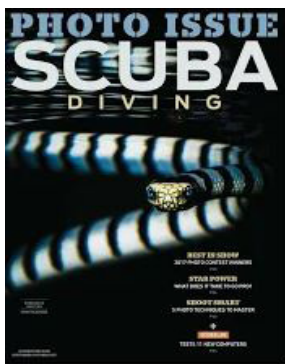
