On Thursday, October 7, 2021, PCC Learning Resource Center conducted a transfer workshop at CE Training Room.

The Career Transfer Counselor from Learning Resource Center, Telbakes Yano, initiated the workshop as a way to give the students a taste of what it is like to study outside of Palau. Mr. Yano believes that it would be a good idea to also have other people speak about their college/university experiences so that the students can have a broader understanding of what to expect when they choose to attend four-year college/university. Academic Advisor Crane Moses and PCC Tourism & Hospitality Instructor Jenelle Blesam were willing to assist in the workshop by sharing their own university experiences alongside Mr. Yano. Invited speakers discussed standard of education, school events, class projects, COVID-19 protocols, and challenges of living outside of Palau. Based on the workshop evaluation,k the workshop was very informative and that one student would like to see more of such workshop conducted in the future for interested students. On October 14, 2021 PCC Financial Aid office begin its week-long financial aid orientation sessions at the college Assembly Hall for all eligible students. Each year, Financial Aid office Director Isumechraard Ngirairikl conducted sessions on federal financial aid to all applicants/recipients. These students are required to attend one of the scheduled financial aid orientation 2 sessions. At each session, students will receive important information about their awards, new federal updates, PCC Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) agreement that each student must adhered to and sign before receiving financial aid award. Other information discussed were the source of funding for students such as Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund which are available for PCC students.

Sessions are conducted in groups according to the first letter of their last names. Director Ngirairikl encourage all eligible students to attend these sessions as it pertains important information on financial aid eligibility.




