On Friday, October 29, 2021 The Ministry of Education Special Education Coordinator Nora Renguul and University of Guam (UOG) Center for Excellence in Developmental Disabilities Education, Research, and Service (CEDDERS) June De Leon visited Palau Community College and met with Dean of Continuing Education Hedrick Kual and PCC President Dr. Patrick U. Tellei. The meeting was to update the status of teachers preparation program for special education teachers in public elementary schools in Palau attending UOG School of Education bachelor's degree program. The program was implemented in accordance to Republic of Palau Public Law (RPPL) No. 10-32 which requires MOE to establish teacher certification program to ensure that all students in Palau's schools will receive the best instruction that allows them to reach their maximum potential. Through formal collaboration and partnership between MOE, PCC, and UOG School of Education the program has begin with 25 teacher scholars who will have to complete 60 credits of upper division education courses.
