

At the Presidential Press Conference this morning, Minister Dr. Dale Jenkins of Education announced that the in-person class suspension for both public and private schools will extend from January 21, 2022 to January 28, 2022. The Palau High School online learning system will continue as scheduled.

The public, especially students and parents, are asked to adhere to MHHS directives regarding isolation and quarantine pending further instruction from the MOE. Parents are highly encouraged to get their children vaccinated as well.


