On May 31, 2022 PCC President Dr. Patrick U. Tellei received a \$10,000 donation from the family of late Mellachelbeluu Wilhelm R. Rengiil, Ms. Kiyoko Rengiil and Daughter Attorney General Ernestine Rengiil to officially create a PCC Based Memorial Scholarship in his honor. Mr. Rengiil not only believes in education but also a life-long teacher and mentor since the inception of Palau Intermediate School in 1948 and successfully became a Principal of Palau Vocational School in 1963. Later in 1969, Mr. Rengiil became a Deputy Director of Micronesian Occupational College until he became the Director in 1972 and eventually the President, a position he held until 1985.

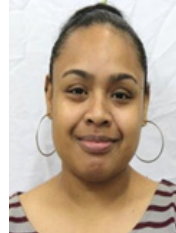
