I. Academic Department Purpose and Relationship to the College Mission

1. State the mission of this academic department below.

The Social Sciences and Humanities (SS/HUM) Department serves as the Liberal Arts Program's main support focusing on academic fields such as history, social sciences, and humanities. Furthermore, the department provides core general education requirements for other academic programs that are also offered at Palau Community College. Academic programs also use SS/HUM courses as other required courses for their program requirements. In order to provide this support, the Social Sciences and Humanities Department covers the academic disciplines of Anthropology, History, Religion, Philosophy, Political Science, Psychology, and Sociology. Each course has developed learning outcomes based on Western standardized theories, concepts, and perspectives while also incorporating various aspects of local concepts and perspectives with specialized areas of study.

2. How is the academic department supporting the overall mission of the College?

The Social Sciences and Humanities courses address various topics which address technical, academic, cultural, social, and economic needs that relate to the academic degree programs that require these courses. In addition, students receive a well-rounded education through the courses which are required under the general education program requirements. Hence, the SS/HUM department courses provide students with a well-rounded accredited degree so that each student should be able to either contribute to the community and/or enter the workforce or enroll into a four-year college/university.

3. Provide a brief history of this academic department below. Include the updates of major changes and accomplishments since the last review.

The Social Sciences and Humanities Department grew with the implementation of the Liberal Arts program. Prior to the degree program's creation, courses in these disciplines were used for certificate and other degree programs, the focus being on the College's technical education programs. In 1983, the college first offered an Associate of Arts degree; the degree program became known as the Liberal Arts program.

Over the years, courses have been developed and added or revised as student/program needs arise. For example, HI149 *History and Culture of the Federated States of Micronesia – Emphasis Yap State* was created for a cohort residing in Yap State, FSM. An education course, *Human Growth and Development*, was recoded from ED to SS and moved to the SS/HUM department because this course can also be a transferrable course for Liberal Arts (LA) students. CO110 *Introduction to Communication* was developed and replaced the old communication course also for the LA program as the old communication course was not a transferrable one.

The Social Sciences and Humanities Department is currently managed by one full time faculty although qualified adjunct faculty assist with the teaching of the varied courses. To date, there are a total of 22 active courses in this department.

Table 1a. Course Completion of Department Courses (Fall) above shows the enrollment of students in all SS/HUM courses in a given fall semester, along with number of students who passed, failed, and withdrew from the courses. Several of the courses, especially SS100 had more than one section offered in a given semester. The data shows the enrollment of students an increased in the last fall semester, with 83%, 91% and 88% respectively passing the courses, 4%, 1% and 4% failing, and 12%, 7% and 9% withdrawing from the courses. The highest enrollment for the fall semester (200) was in fall 2020; fall 2018 and fall 2019 tied with 4% failures; fall 2018 had the highest withdrawal percentage. The numbers show that majority of the students who enrolled in SS/HUM courses remained in the courses and successfully completed the courses.

Table 1b. Course Completion of Department Courses (Spring) above shows the enrollment of students in all SS/HUM courses in a given spring semester, along with number of students who passed, failed, and withdrew from the courses. Several of the courses, especially SS100 had more than one section offered in a given semester. The data shows the enrollment of students decreasing in spring 2020 and then increasing slightly in the spring 2021 semester, with 81%, 83% and 90% respectively passing the courses, 5%, 6% and 3% failing, and 14%, 11% and 7% withdrawing from the courses. The highest enrollment for the fall semester was in spring 2019 (187), spring 2020 had the highest

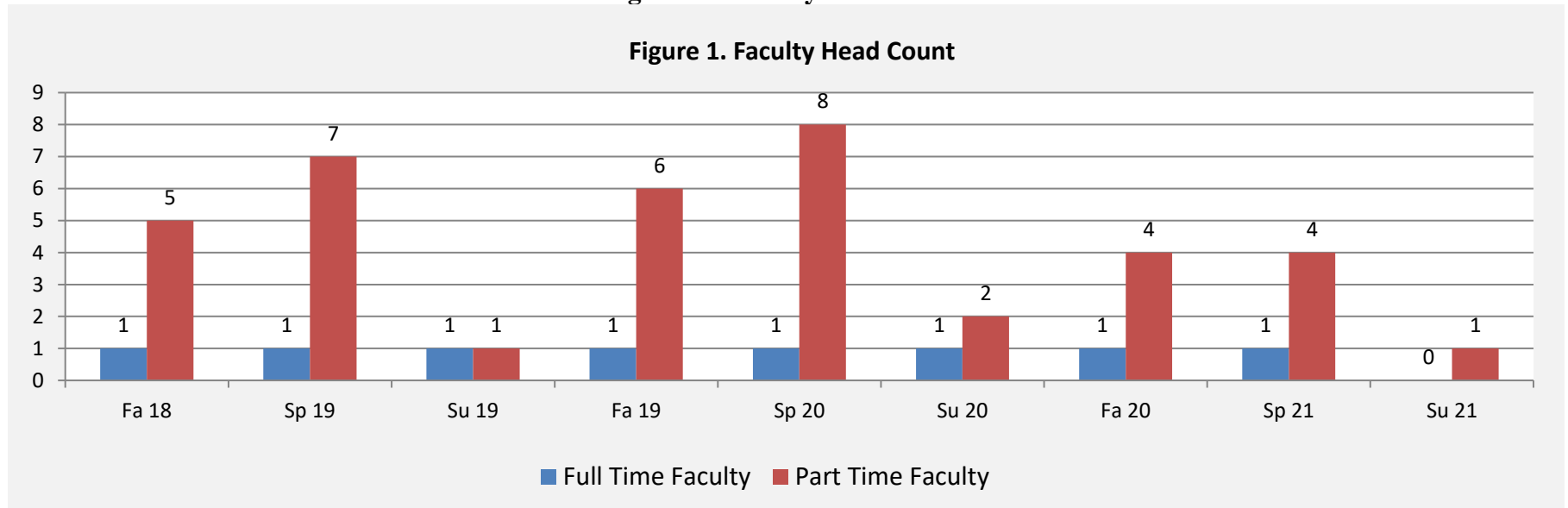
failures at 6% and spring 2019 also had the highest withdrawal percentage, 14%. The numbers show that majority of the students who enrolled in SS/HUM courses remained in the courses and successfully completed the courses. It should be noted that in spring 2020 and spring 2021 due to the rise in Covid-19 cases, most courses converted to a delivery mode of hybrid or totally virtual.

Table 1c. Course Completion of Department Courses (Summer) above shows the enrollment of students in all SS/HUM courses in a given summer semester, along with number of students who passed, failed, and withdrew from the courses. It should be noted that the summer session is mainly for internship students, students needing only one course to complete graduation requirements or students who want to complete their mathematics and English required courses. New students will usually take the mandatory SS/HUM requirement of SS100 *Introduction to College* also. Other SS/Hum courses will be offered based on special student needs. For example, in-service teachers may take an SS/HUM course which is a requirement for their program during the summer session when they are not in the classroom teaching or those preparing for their bachelor’s degree may also take required transferable SS/HUM courses.

In summer 2019, only 2 courses were offered with 94% passing, 6% failing and no withdrawals. Summer 2020 shows 3 courses offered with 98% passing, 1% failing and 1% withdrawal. In summer session 2021 only SS100 was offered with 74 students enrolling. The passing rate was 95%, with no failures and a 5% withdrawal rate. The numbers show that majority of the students who enrolled in SS/HUM courses remained in the courses and successfully completed the courses.

Overall, over this three year review period, the majority of students do not withdraw from the social sciences/humanities courses and are successfully completing the courses.

Figure 1 – Faculty Information above displays the number of full time and part time faculty who teach SS/HUM courses per semester. The data displays that there was only 1 full time faculty from fall 2018 to summer 2021. The number of part time faculty ranged from 1 to 8 per semester, which is an average of 4.2 part time faculty per semester. The results of this data indicate that there is always a need to hire part time faculty to assist in teaching SS/HUM courses. Currently, there is only one full time faculty who instructs the SS/HUM courses and who is also the department chair. While there was a change in personnel for the department chair, the number remained at one full time faculty. These results show that the department could use another full time faculty.

- Currently, there are a total of 22 active courses under the SS/HUM Dept., all of which have course learning outlines (CLOs). The CLOs were modified and updated and all outlines except one were approved by the CPC in the school year of 2016-2017 (see appendix B).
- One outline was revised in spring 2020 with description, textbook, and student learning and course learning outcome changes (see appendix B).
- All course CLOs have been aligned with GE PLOs and ILOs in the SS/HUM Dept. mapping. The mapping was revised in 2020 (see appendix A).
- All courses except SS203 need to undergo a 5-year review. This should have been completed in school year 2021 (see appendix B).

- The assessment results from the last cycle (fa2015 to su2018) assisted the department instructor in analyzing and improving the class activities for the courses for students in order for them to engage in class discussions, pose questions to improve critical thinking and problem skills, and analyze literature (articles, books, journals etc.) to make relevant with current issues.
- For most of the courses, the course assessment FAMED grids did not match the mapping grid. Therefore, the mapping followed the FAMED grid mapping. It appears that faculty assessing the courses simply followed the last semester assessed FAMED grid rather than referring to the revised mapping grid. This may be due to many adjunct faculty teaching rather than consistent full time faculty teaching more of the SS/HUM courses. Instead of reviewing the latest revised mapping grid, most likely the faculty relied on the previously assessed FAMED grid to follow its mapping. Only two courses in fall 2020 used the latest mapping grid when assessing courses that semester.

- Students improved in proficiency since the last department review cycle of 2015 to 2018. Only three (3) CLOs assessed were below the 70% benchmark. One was from SS179 and two were from SS119; all were in fall 2020.
- The increased and improved class activities, which was an action plan from a previous assessed semester, appear to have made a difference in reaching the 70% benchmark for proficiency.

The overall GE/ILO proficiency level for spring 2021 is 99%.

- G. Overall, the assessment of the GE/ILOs each semester showed that students reached the 70% benchmark. Many averaged in the high 90% or even 100%. There was only one GE/ILO in fall 2020 that did not reach the benchmark of 70%. For GE/ILO 5, only 50% of the students assessed showed proficiency. The course was SS179 and CLO 3 was mapped to GE/ILO 5. However, when averaged with other courses and CLOs mapped to GE/ILO 5, the benchmark was met. Each semester the overall average was well above the 70% benchmark.
- H. For most of the courses, the course assessment FAMED grids did not match the mapping grid. Therefore, the mapping followed the FAMED grid mapping. It appears that faculty assessing the courses simply followed the last semester's assessed FAMED grid mapping rather than referring to the latest mapping grid. This may be a result of having many adjunct faculty teaching each semester.
- I. Some course assessment was not found during this review period. Therefore, the GE/ILOs were not able to be mapped. It is noted when no assessment was found even though the courses were scheduled to be assessed.

- Some of the requested resources were purchased such as the external-drive; the chair is now able to store all the important data for the department as electronic files. Also, a laptop has been provided for the instructor.
- SS instructor met with part time instructors individually to address student issues and also have discussion on how to assist the students to succeed.
- Review and update outlines will be ongoing to keep courses relevant and current.
- On island conferences will be also ongoing as they are available and funding permits.

Did the completed actions lead to improvement of student learning?

Although most of the planned actions are still ongoing, they have contributed to the improvement of student learning. Ongoing dialogue with other faculty regarding student issues, such as motivating students and sharing ideas to improve classroom activities, may have contributed to more students who were assessed reaching the benchmark of 70%.

What modifications do you plan to make to the department in the future to improve student learning?

The changes that need to be made to the department to improve student learning include:

- A. Hire one qualified full time faculty. A full time/long term committed candidate is very much needed in order to stabilize the long-term development and consistency of the department in an effort to curtail either a possible shortage of instructors and/or a high turnover rate.
- B. Plan to conduct monthly meetings which will allow for instructors to share any changes/modifications they see fit to improve course learning outcomes. This plan will also ensure constant communication between faculty for improvement of courses and student learning.
- C. Continue to review and update course learning outlines to ensure better alignment between what is taught in the classroom and what students are evaluated on. The plan will also make sure consistent and updated alignment of CLOs to GE PLOs to ILOs and keep courses current and relevant.
- D. Participate in professional development for instructors and assistant instructors. The plan will ensure instructors are up-to-date on the latest techniques and relevant information for improvement of student learning.
- E. Continue to assess and make necessary improvement to classrooms to ensure a conducive learning environment for both faculty and students. A television has been mounted in the classroom and will be used fall 2022.

Although assessment results show improvement in students meeting the expected proficiency levels for CLOs and GE/ILOs, the courses taught by adjunct faculty, not also full-time faculty in other programs/departments, cause inconsistency in the course assessment and signature assignments are not always aligned well with the CLOs. This is one reason the SS/HUM Dept. has a need to hire another full-time instructor to avoid discrepancy. Concurrently, having another SS/HUM Dept. instructor ensures that there is another instructor to assist in the contribution of ideas to improve the department’s objectives; thus, enhancing and improve the students’ learning.
