Summary of Description:

Palau Community College is seeking a qualified individual as an instructor for the School of Tourism & Hospitality (T & H). As an instructor you will be providing and teaching course materials related to food, nutrition, hospitality, tourism, and management in the T & H field. You will be teaching and evaluating student performance, maintaining accurate student records, and helping to evaluate departmental course learning outcomes.

Examples of Duties consist, but are not limited to:

- 1. Teach courses on a wide variety of subjects within Tourism & Hospitality, such as culinary arts (planning, preparation, production, and service) hospitality management, and food & beverage service management.
- 2. Develop course curriculum and ensuring that they meet college and departmental standards.
- 3. Plan lessons and assignments.
- 4. Assess student progress through assignments and tests.
- 5. Keep up to date with changes and innovations in the field.
- 6. Supervise and coordinate student programs and activities.
- 7. Develop recipes and presentations.
- 8. Monitor sanitation check freshness of foods and ingredients, inspect all supplies, equipments, work area and grounds for cleanliness and functionality.
- 9. Order and maintain inventory of all food and supplies.
- 10. Provide student critiques, advice and guidance on industry standards.
- 11. Provide student basic advice on field of expertise.
- 12. Network with private companies outside of PCC to help place graduates with field related work.

Minimum Qualification/Requirements:

Bachelors or AS degree in Tourism & Hospitality or related field. Five (5) years experience in the preparation of foods used in a culinary and/or hospitality environment. Demonstrated instructional or work experience in hospitality, restaurant, culinary, or tourism management preferred. All appropriate licenses for food & beverage (F&B) required. Must maintain a well groomed appearance. Must possess strong communication skills (writing/speaking English). Additional language skill desirable. Proficiency in speaking Palauan preferred, but not required.
