On March 5, 2024, PCC president Dr. Patrick U. Tellei had the opportunity to speak with Palau High School (PHS) Seniors to inform them of the various education opportunities available for them. The students in this era are fortunate to have scholarships and opportunities and they should have the knowledge and materials to access them. Dr. Tellei had the pleasure to inform them about the PCC STEM (science, technology, engineering, mathematics) Discipline Program. The STEM Discipline Associate of Arts program provides students with core education in these fields, and prepare them for entry in to a four-year long program. This program was especially chosen to be presented to the students because over the past several years, there had been a demand for, as well as a shortage of workers with skills in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics in both the public and private sectors in our island nation. PCC has secured grant money to assist students interested in any of the STEM fields, to begin two years and continue on to a four year college/ university. The grant money is from the Islands of Opportunity Alliance Louis Stokes Alliances for Minority Participation (IOA-LSAMP) which supports the quantity and quality of students completing STEM Bachelor's degree programs.


