## PREPARING FOR THE 2024-2025 FAFSA APPLICATION

Federal Student Aid

#### **Better FAFSA Better Future**

The Fostering Undergraduate Talent by Unlocking Resources for Education Act (Future Act), 2020, and the FAFSA Simplification Act (Act) (passed as part of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021, and amended by the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2022), made many important amendments to the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended (HEA), including significant changes to the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) form. Incorporating these changes delayed the availability of the FAFSA which only became available on December 31, 2023, unlike previous years where it becomes available annually on October 1st.

Changes to the FAFSA Application include fewer questions, the ability for an applicant to list up to 20 schools via the online application, replacing the Expected Family Contribution (EFC) with the Student Aid Index (SAI), and having contributors (student, spouse, student's parents) provide consent to have their Federal Tax Information (FTI) transferred directly from the IRS (Internal Revenue Service) to the FAFSA application. If all contributors do not provide consent, the student is not eligible for aid.

Palau will be prompted to manually enter their income and tax data because they will not have tax information available to retrieve from the IRS. As in previous years, applicants and their contributors will be instructed to enter financial information from their foreign or U.S. territory tax return that is equivalent to the income and tax information found on an IRS Form 1040 or 1040-NR (adjusted gross income (AGI), income tax paid, and certain untaxed income). Applicants and their contributors are still required to provide consent and approval to use IRS FTI (Federal Tax Information), even if such FTI does not exist with the IRS, as a condition of federal student aid eligibility under the FUTURE Act.

Interested students can apply by going online at https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa or by filling out the paper FAFSA application and mailing it to the address provided on the last page of the application. When applying online, there will be a two-step verification, and all FAFSA contributors must create an account to be able to log in and complete their portion of the online form. Due to the recent FAFSA changes, the FAFSA website is undergoing periodic maintenance therefore it may take contributors multiple attempts to successfully access the site. In addition, if an applicant does not have a U.S. Social Security Number, you may be prompted to call a specified number for verification purposes. The Palau Community College Financial Aid Office will be meeting with all high school seniors and Palau Community College students beginning February 2024 to assist them with the FAFSA application process. 
