On May 15, 2024 Mr. Satoshi Sasakura, the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) Survey Team, Palau Community College (PCC) Science students and the PCC Cooperative Research and Extension (CRE) Aquaculture staff did a noontime seminar about Microalgae. Mr. Sasakura and the JICA team presented on how important microalgae is to Palau, as well as the ocean as a whole. The students and CRE aquaculture staff presented their findings on a project in which they study Palau's seas from different states/ places and analyze which microalgae were found and how many they found. Surpisingly, microalgae is everywhere and the species they found vary according to the place they found, whether it is sunny or shady.
