Palau Community College (PCC) held a Noontime Seminar on August 6, 2024 featuring guest speaker Captain E. Ben Flaherty of the United States Marine Corps (USMC). Captain Flaherty briefly spoke about building a criminal trial. The backwards technique he uses to prepare for a criminal trial is to think of his closing argument first, which is a concluding statement that reiterates all the important arguments and evidence that will convince a jury to decide in your favor. He then makes a list of key or expert witnesses and the questions he will ask them that will support his closing argument. Lastly, he looks at the investigation, which is the way he is going to examine the case and do his research. To help us understand the topic even further, he talked about a real case that he worked on. To be sure the audience has a better understanding on what he does, he involved them by asking them questions and did a cross-examination activity. PCC thanks you, Captain Flaherty, for taking the time to speak with us and we look forward to more seminars with the USMC.

To activate your palau.edu email address:

1. Open a web browser (Chrome, Internet, Safari, Firefox, etc.) and navigate to the site mail.palau.edu or gmail.com.
2. Once the page loads, enter your username and password. Your username is your firstname plus your lastname (all lowercase and no spaces). Your password is your PCC student ID number. If your ID number contains 7 or less numbers, add 0s at the end so that you have at least 8 numbers.
