

The instructor/tutor will work with UB participants to help with academic assignments, research, etc.

Minimum Qualification Requirements for Tutors:

Bachelor's degree in specific academic discipline or secondary education, or two years teaching/tutoring experience in appropriate content area. Preferred qualification includes; experience working with high school students from low-income families and/or first-generation college students.
