On October 7, 2024, the Computer Services Division and PCC President Dr. Patrick U. Tellei had the opportunity to meet with researchers from Institute of Marine Geodynamics (IMG), Japan Agency for Marine-Earth Science and Technology (JAMSTEC). Mr. Yasushi Ishihara, Director in-charge of earthquake observation in Asia-Pa- cific region, principal research technician of IMG, JAMSTEC, Japan and Ms. Junko Yoshimitsu, re- search technician, geophysical research group of IMG, JAMSTEC, Japan were here to meet with Director of the PCC Computer Division Bruce Ri- mirch, Systems Analyst Johvanna Yaoch and Com- puter Technicians Alik Ulechong and Shaik Higa. IMG conducts large-scale research and observa- tion using JAMSTEC-owned research vessels and observation equipment to elucidate the occurrence of and circumstances affecting earthquakes and volcanic activities. In addition, highly accurate numerical simulations are conducted to predict the future trends of these activities.
