JAPANESE KAWASAKI & MITSUBISHI RESEARCHERS MEET WITH PCC PRESIDENT

On October 23, 2024, Mr. Yuma Kondo (Commercial Manager of IVSG Project of Kawasaki Heavy Industries, Ltd.), Mr. Ibuki Masuda and Mr. Taisei Segami (both are Consultants of Mitsubishi Research Institute, Inc.) came to Palau Community College (PCC) to meet with PCC President Dr. Patrick U. Tellei, PCC Vice President Jay Olegeriil, Associate Dean Ulai T. Ikesiil, and Continuing Education Dean Hedrick Kual. The three of them are currently working in collaboration with Palau Public Utilities Corporation (PPUC), with the support of Japan's Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry (METI), to explore the introduction of new technologies aimed at strengthening the energy infrastructure in Palau. The Saipan (CNMI) Pickleball Federation's President Dr. Nelson Krum will sends his regards, and will schedule to come to Palau to promote and train people who are interested in learning the sport. Here to present the donation on his behalf are Pastor Eric Abragan and Worship Pastor Elmor De Rosas. Mr. Abragan and Mr. De Rosas did a pickleball clinic at PCC Mesekiu Gym on October 22 and 23, 2024 with PCC students, staff and faculty, as well as community members. The equipments donated include a portable pickleball net (full), bag, eight (8) pickleball paddles, six (6) pickleballs, and a kids pickleball net. Mr. Abragan and Mr. De Rosas reiterated that pickleball, a hybrid of badminton, tennis and pingpong, is the fastest-growing sport and there are nearly 5 million players worldwide. They wanted to spread the popularity of the sport to Palau and their goal is to start a federation here and everywhere, until pickleball makes it to the olympics.


