## PCC Holds 2024 Thanksgiving

On November 27, 2024, Palau Community College (PCC) held its Annual Thanksgiving Endowment Fundraising. PCC President Dr. Tellei, Student Trustee Ms. Suanda Obakerbau, Associated Students of PCC and members of the Executive Committee gave remarks via live radio talkshow courtesy of the Ministry of State "Eco Paradise 87.9 FM Radio." The college fundraising event was able to raise over \$73,000 due to the support of the community members who purchased raffle tickets at \$10 each and cash donations from local businesses, elected government leaders, individuals, and local women's group. Some local businesses also donated in-kind prizes for the raffle drawing to help with the fundraiser. This year, the college fundraising had a total of 60 prizes including the Baby Grand Prize and Grand Prize. The Grand Prize, same as last year, is a 14' x 24' Summer House valued at \$8,500 with a \$200 cash prize. This year the winner of the first prize went to Ngarachamayong (chainsaw with Palauan CD and cassette), Baby Grand Prize went to the Women's Group Ngara Maiberel (Twin tub washer), and the grand prize went to National Development Bank (NDBP). #### PCC Business Law Class Holds Students Debate at Assembly Hall

On December 4, 2024, PCC Business Administration students enrolled in BU 214 "Business Law" held a student debate on more contentious issues in Palau. BU 214 course enables students to demonstrate knowledge they acquired from various theories of business law and put them into practice by debating on local issues pertinent to local the community. Two main topic assigned for this event were Topic #1: Is the imposition of traditional law "Bul" by the House of Traditional Leaders in Koror an effective solution to rising crime rates?, and Topic #2: Should Palau prioritize environmental laws over economic development projects? BU 214 instructor Frederick D. Mascardo served as the moderator while Director of Development Harriette Herman, Director of Library Services Cecil Meteolechol, Associate Dean Marianne Temaungil and Instructor Arlyn Ignacio served as the judges. The students were split into two teams, one served as the affirmative as the other was the opposition. The winners of topic one was the opposition team, while the affirmative team took the win on the second topic.
