

# TAN SIU LIN PCC LIBRARY'S NEW SIGN



On Wednesday, January 8, 2025, the Tan Siu Lin PCC Library's sign was replaced with a new and improved one. The previous sign got old and worn out overtime, however, it is now fresh, shiny and stands out more. Since its opening in April of 2009, the PCC Library has become the Republic of Palau's largest library. It has books for all ages, periodicals, government documents, videos, and maps. While most materials are in English, there are also materials in Palauan, as well as a growing International Collection with more than 1,300 volumes, mostly in Japanese, but also in Chinese, French, Hungarian, German, Filipino, Korean, Czech, Dutch, Hebrew, Italian, Hindi, Swedish, and Spanish. There are 20 desktop PCs, available to students and the general public for e-mail, word processing, and research needs. The library's online public access catalog is available on two computer stations in the library, as well as any computer with Internet access at http://library.palau.edu. The library will be closed today, January 10, 2025, for a general cleanup and will resume regular hours on January 11, 2025. His focus subjects are geology and geoscience education. # **DR. CONSTANZE DUPONT PRES-ENTS NEW PUBLICATIONS TO PCC**

On January 8, 2025, Dr. Constanze Dupont visited the college to meet with PCC President Dr. Patrick U. Tellei. During the visit, she presented two new publications published by herself and Mandy Etpison. The two-volume set includes Palau in Photos from 1875 to 1915, as well asPalau in Europe, a catalog of Palauan artifacts in European collections dating from 1785 to 1910. Dr. Constanze Dupont is an independent German Researcher and anthropologist who has been in Palau for many years now, researching and analyzing artifacts, old graves, and even went back to Germany to resurrect a 107 year old Bai (men's meeting house) with PCC President Dr. Patrick U. Tellei, Dr. Ngirachitei Victor Yano and the construction team. Ms. Mandy Etpison emphasized her and Dr. Dupont's work in an interview with Island Times stating that the photos and information in the books have not been publicized before and went on to highlight the challenges of identifying and reclaiming historical records of Palauan people, artifacts and places. High Chief Reklai of Melkeok has also praised these two publishers for the wonderful work they have done, because to him the books evoke deep personal connections and would serve as valuable resources for all schools in Palau. The book is now sold at both Etpison Museum and Belau National Museum and major departmental stores priced at \$45 a set. PCC extends its gratitude to Dr. Dupont and Ms. Etpison for not only providing a copy to the college, but for publishing a book about our small island nation's history.




