### PCC & MELILT CLAN SIGNED Addendum to Lease Agreement

Reklai, Student Trustee Suanda Obakerbau, ASPCC Shamira Cruz, Masubed Skebong, Belechel Foober Obichang Skebong, staff, a nd students during a sign-On March 13, 2025 Palau Community College and Melilt Clan of Ngeremlengui State officially signed an addendum to the leass agreement of September 2021 regarding a parcel of land situated in Ngeremlengui State. Present to signed the agreement were PCC Board of Trustees Acting Chair Alvina Timarong, PCC President Dr. Patrick U. Tellei and Melilt Clan representatives: Ngiramelilt John B. Skebong, Belechel Foober Obichang Skebong, and Masubed Skebong.

The amendment to lease agreement which containe the land size of 94,000 square meters is replaced with 95,703 square meters which is the actual size of Ngerikrongel land. In addition, the term for the lease agreement shall be for not less than 50 years and shall continue thereafter until such time when PCC no longer has the use for the land under this lease agreement. Moreover, the lease agreement acknowledged the rental payment to be stipulated according to the agreement which in light of Ngiramelilt John B. Skebong, Belechel Foober Obichang Skebong, and Masubed Skebong request, the payment for the 50 year lease agreement was initiated in lump sum to complete rental payments on the remaining years.


