In January 2024, the ISSA Committee completed its five-year review of the College's seven ISSAs. The Committee reviewed results from AY 2018-2023 and prior years, and the recommendations were approved by the College President on March 11, 2024, and were implemented in Academic Year 2024-2025

Course Completion

At least 70% of registered students will complete enrolled courses (course completion) in any given semester.

Retention

PCC retains at least 60% of registered students from term to term; fall to spring; and fall to fall until completion of degree/certificate programs.

At least <u>70%</u> of registered students will complete enrolled general education courses in any given semester.

At least <u>20%</u> of students who completed degree programs will transfer to 4-year colleges/universities. Stretch goal 25%.



At least <u>50%</u> of students who completed degree/certificate programs will enter the workforce (job placement).




















