

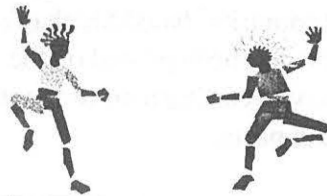
## Are You Thinking About Taking College Level Courses But You Cannot Because of Your Work?

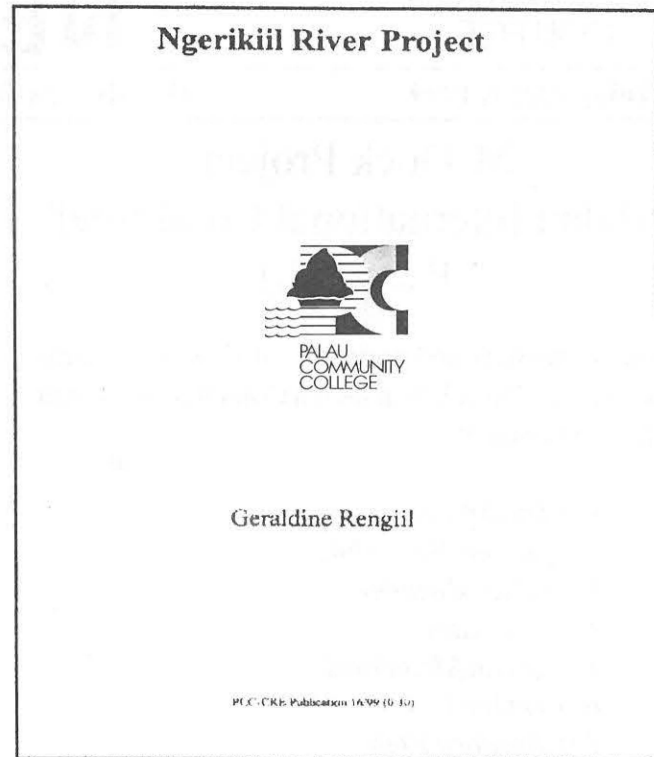
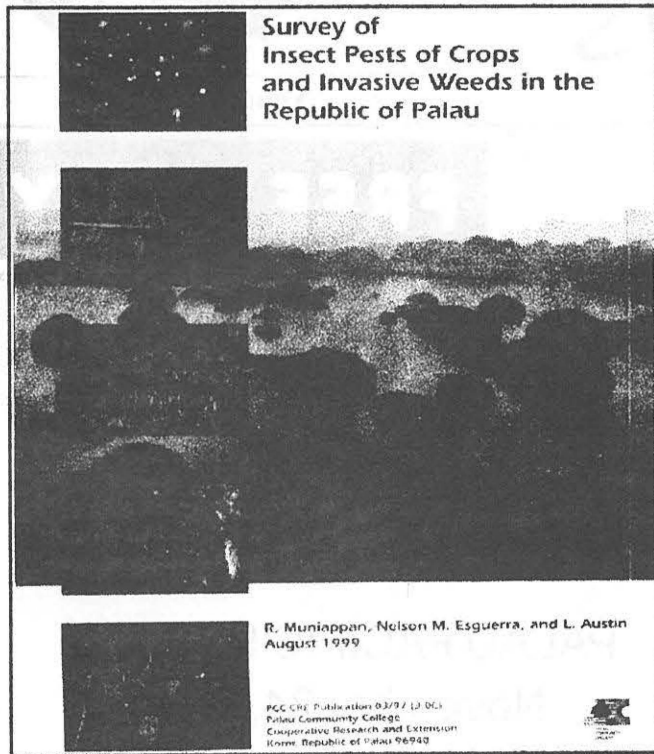

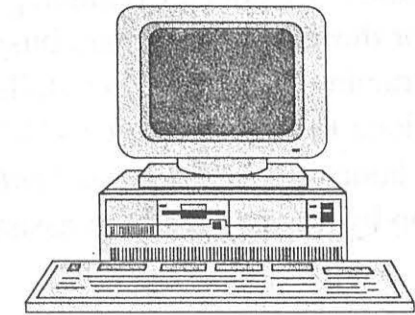
You library cards are now ready! Please stop by the PCC Library to pick up your colorful library card with your personal barcode this week. Bring your student ID card with you for verification. Thank you.
