## Instructor Helps Okayama Univ. Professors with Research

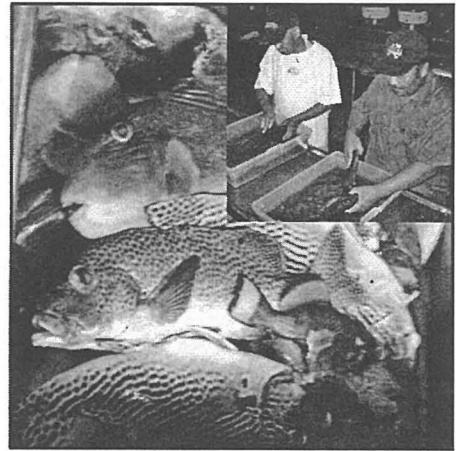
