**Course Description as It Will Appear in the Catalog:**

**BA130 ACCOUNTING PRINCIPLES I (3)**

This introductory course establishes a foundation in financial accounting by exploring how business transactions are recorded, summarized, and communicated to external stakeholders. Often referred to as the "language of business," students learn to translate economic activities into structured financial data to support informed decision-making. The course will introduce students to various accounting concepts and principles, the accounting cycle, internal control and cash, receivables, inventories, and the process and design of financial statements. Pre: none (3 credits lec.)

**Course Description as It Will Appear in the Catalog:**

**NU101 INTRODUCTION TO NURSING, PHARMACOLOGY AND MEDICAL TERMINOLOGY (3)**

This introductory course provides a foundation for students entering a college-level nursing program and preparing for a career in nursing. It offers an overview of the nursing profession while introducing essential concepts in pharmacology and medical terminology. Students will engage with learning outcomes that integrate principles from anatomy, chemistry, microbiology, psychology, and foundational English and mathematics. Emphasizing evidence-based practice, the course equips students with the knowledge and skills necessary to succeed throughout the nursing curriculum and to thrive in diverse health care settings. Pre: none (3 credit lec)

- NU207 has a new course description and is now 4 credits with co-requisites

**Course Description as It Will Appear in the Catalog:**

**NU207 DECISION MAKING AND LEADERSHIP (4)**

This course examines the legal, ethical, and legislative issues that shape the professional responsibilities of registered nurses (RNs) in contemporary healthcare. Students will be introduced to foundational leadership and management concepts, exploring the roles and functions of RNs as leaders and managers within diverse care settings. Emphasis is placed on nursing ethics, including the ethical dilemmas and legal ramifications nurses may encounter in practice. Through a focus on interprofessional collaboration, evidence-based practice, and professional growth, the course prepares nurses to lead and manage effectively, safely, and with integrity in complex healthcare environments. Coreq: NU204 and NU206 (4 credits lec)
